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CHANGES TO CAR PARK TERMS

Over the recent months we have experienced problems with people parking in our car parks who are not attending our events or staying in the hotel, reducing the amount of available car parking spaces for our own customers. We have therefore engaged a car parking company – Creative Parking – who will be monitoring car movement.

Parking will continue to be free of charge to all our patrons using The Concorde and Ellington Lodge hotel, but you will need to register your car registration details at your point of entry each time you visit the Club, Moldy Fig, Hotel or the marquee; there will be a tablet at both Receptions and in the marquee for you to do this. Once you have registered your number on the system it will allow you free parking for up to 24 hours in our car parks. The system goes live on 8th July.

If you do not register your vehicle details on the day or night of your visit you will be liable for a fine, issued by Creative Parking.

We regret having to introduce this system and apologise for any inconvenience it may cause but due to our proximity to transport links ie railway and airport we feel this is a necessary step to stop people using our car park for extended parking elsewhere. It is also a positive step in providing extra security for car movement in our car parks and trust you will understand our reasons for implementing this.

Please note, there is no financial gain to The Concorde for the installation of the parking system and going forward we hope this will alleviate some of the issues we have experienced with external cars taking up car parking spaces designated for our own customers.
